Instructions for the applicants

1. Only online application and online payments are allowed.
2. For online form fill up, please visit the college website – www.onlineadmissionbcc.in

Candidates are requested to go through the website regularly to update themselves for the latest information www.onlineadmissionbcc.in
3. All future communications from the college will be made to the registered email ID/mobile number. Thus, it is essential to have a **valid mobile number** and a **unique valid email ID**. The college will not be held responsible for non-receipt of any communication due to wrong/non-existing/non-functional/changed mobile number/ email ID or due to network interruption.
4. The information given by the applicants must be correct. Any discrepancy may result in the cancellation of admission.
5. **Cost of Online Registration and Admission Test: Rs. 200.00 for each subject.**

All the fees are to be paid by Net Banking/ Debit Card/ Credit Card/ UPI only, not refundable under any circumstances. Do not wait for the last day to pay registration fees to avoid payment failure by Bank or Payment Gateway.
6. Only **regular candidates** who have passed the Higher Secondary/equivalent examination in **2023** or **2022** will be eligible to apply.
7. If any candidate fails to fulfil the eligibility criteria as mentioned, his/her candidature will automatically stand cancelled at any point of the admission process.
8. For any query, the candidates may send mails to the college only from **their registered email ids**. The helpdesk mail id of the college for the purpose of admission is helpdesk@bankurachristiancollege.in. Queries sent to other email ids of the college will not be entertained.
9. No change of scheduled date and time of admission test(s) will be entertained under any circumstances.
10. The college authority, under unavoidable circumstances, may change the date and time of any part of the schedule mentioned in this information bulletin. However, such changes will be notified on the college website before 06:00 p.m. on the immediately preceding day. Therefore, all candidates are requested to check the website every day after 6:00 p.m. to be sure of the date and time.
11. The candidates must check the date and the time of their admission tests and be present at the venue accordingly.

12. Norms for the preparation of Merit List for admission:

Equal weightage will be given to the aggregate score of

- i. Total marks obtained in the top four subjects of HS/Equivalent examination (excluding Environmental Studies)
and
- ii. Marks obtained in the Admission Test related to the subject concerned,
BCCAT-2023.

In other words, 50% of the marks in aggregate in the top four subjects (excluding Environmental Studies) obtained in HS/Equivalent examination and 50% of the marks obtained in Admission Test in the subject concerned will be taken into consideration for preparation of Merit List for Admission.

14. **Syllabus:**

- Examinations in **BCCAT-2023** will be subject specific.
- The syllabus of the Admission Test for each subject will have parity with 10+2 level syllabus of the subject concerned. For instance, a candidate applying for the subject history shall have to take the Admission Test in History itself. The same is true for all subjects except students applying for Botany, Zoology and Physiology.
- The candidates applying for Botany, Zoology and Physiology should consult the syllabus of Biological Sciences at the 10+2 level. They have to take a common admission test on Biological Sciences which will allow them to be eligible for admission in Botany/Zoology/Physiology.
- For each subject, 90% of the questions will be set from the subject itself and 10% from general awareness.

15. If any information like name, father's name, mother's name, gender, category and date of birth given in the application **needs to be corrected**, the rectification may be done by the candidate only within the **correction period**. (See **TIMELINE in Page 2**)

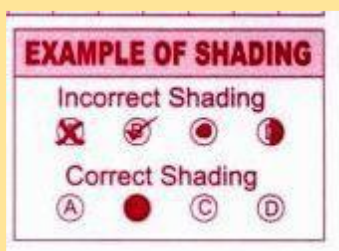
16. **A candidate can apply for a maximum of 3 (three) subjects.**

17. **Pattern of Question Papers**

In every subject concerned, there will be **Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)** with four answer options. There will be **50 (fifty)** questions in each subject with **full marks 100** and the duration of test will be **60 (sixty)** minutes.

18. **Mode of answering questions**

- Questions are to be answered on specially designed Optical Machine-readable Response (**OMR**) sheet.
- Candidates will respond to the questions by darkening **the appropriate circle/bubble completely with black ink ball point pen**.
- See Picture below for Incorrect and Correct method of shading.



19. Scoring Methodology

- All questions will have four answer options.
- Only one option is correct.
- Correct response will yield 2 (two) marks.

21. Evaluation and declaration of results

- Model Answer Keys will be available for a brief period on the college website. Candidates can log in and view the model answer keys. **(See TIMELINE in Page 2)**
- Candidates can also challenge any answer on payment of ₹ 100 (Rupees One hundred only) per question plus the bank's service charges, if any. **(See TIMELINE in Page 2)**
- The college will review the challenges and act accordingly. **The decision of the college authority in this regard will be final and no further communication will be entertained.**
- A candidate can view the images of his/her OMRs and machine read responses by logging in with his/her password. Candidates should download and preserve copies of their OMRs.

22. Rules of the Admission Test (BCCAT-2023)

- a. Candidates must reach the examination centre at least 30 minutes before commencement of the test.
- b. Candidates must be sure of the exact location of their examination centre to avoid any inconvenience. Candidates are advised to occupy their seats at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the test.
- c. No candidate will be allowed to appear for the test in any centre other than the one allotted to him/her and as is mentioned in the admit card.
- d. An applicant has to **carry the following documents** to enter the examination center:
 - i. A printed copy of Admit Card
 - ii. Any photo identity card in original such as Aadhaar Card/ Pan Card / Passport/Voter Card/ 10th standard Admit Card.
- e. Candidates are not allowed to carry any written or printed material, calculator, log table, wristwatch, smart watch, any communication device, like mobile any blue tooth device etc. inside the examination hall. Any candidate found with such items will be reported against and his/her candidature will be summarily cancelled.

Candidates are allowed to carry **Black Ball Point Pen**, Transparent Water Bottle, Admit Card of BCCAT-2023 and valid photo id proof listed above.
- f. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre **beyond the scheduled time of commencement of the test under any circumstances.**
- g. Candidates are asked to put their signature on the top of the Question Booklet as instructed.
- h. Candidates are asked to read the instructions given on OMR and on the cover page of Question Booklet very carefully.
- i. Candidates have to write their name in BLOCK LETTERS. They have to put their signature in appropriate places on the OMR. They must not put any stray mark anywhere else; it may lead to rejection of the OMR.
- j. One must check that his/her Roll Number, photograph, spelling of the name in the attendance sheet match with those given in the Admit Card.
- k. The candidates are to check all the pages of the Question Booklet. If there is any damage or missing page or any difficulty in reading the Question Booklet, the invigilator may be requested to replace the same.

- l. If any candidate is found adopting any unfair means during the examination, his/her candidature will be cancelled, and / or he/she will be debarred either permanently or for a period as is deemed fit by the competent authority. No discussion will be allowed with the invigilator regarding any question.
- m. No candidate will leave the hall till the end of the test and till all OMRs are collected and tallied by the invigilator.
23. Once an application is received, it will be construed that the candidate agrees to all the terms and conditions, rules and regulations stipulated in the Information Bulletin and in the relevant notice(s) published by the College for the said purpose.
24. Any application not in compliance with the conditions specified in the Information Bulletin is liable to be rejected.
25. Appearing for the examination and even obtaining a rank do not guarantee admission.
26. This score of the Admission Test (BCCAT-2023) will be valid only for the session 2023-24.

27. Hostel Admission:

Modalities for admission to different hostels for the session 2023-24 will be published in the college website tentatively after the commencement of admission.

List of candidates seeking admission to different hostels will be prepared on the basis of their marks in HS/equivalent examination and at a minimum of 30 km distance between the College and their permanent residence.
