3. Intake for Major Subject

5. No. of chances

Applicants are advised to check their status (CONFIRMED/WAITING) in the merit lists without waiting for SMS/Email to ensure that there is no room for error. The merit lists will be published as per the schedule. If their status is CONFIRMED, applicants should proceed to take admission through the online portal by paying the requisite admission fee within the stipulated date and time.

After taking provisional admission in a subject, applicants will be allowed to change their subject(s) twice if their status is 'CONFIRMED' on subsequent merit list(s), if any. Each candidate will be given a total of three chances, subject to the availability of vacancies.

If an applicant fails to take admission within the stipulated date and time, despite having a 'CONFIRMED' status, it will be assumed that they are not interested in that subject. The said seat will be declared vacant for the following merit list, if any, and no further requests for admission in that subject in subsequent merit list(s) will be entertained. However, the applicant concerned will still be allowed to take admission in subsequent merit lists if their status in those Merit List(s) is 'CONFIRMED', regardless of their 'CONFIRMED' status in the previous merit list. In other words, it is not mandatory for applicants to take admission in order to be eligible for admission in subsequent merit list(s).

6. Commencement of classes and verification of ORIGINAL TESTIMONIALS

Classes will commence on August 01, 2025.

ORIGINAL TESTIMONIALS will be verified at the college premises from July 23 to 26, 2025. Department-wise detailed schedule will be published on the website.

It is to be noted that all admissions done through the online system are provisional, subject to physical verification of original testimonials by the College Authority and approval of Bankura University.

Therefore, all applicants are hereby asked to be present physically in the college premises for verification of ORIGINAL TESTIMONIALS from July 23 to 26, 2025, as per the schedule that would be notified later. It is mandatory to attend the said verification process to continue his/her study in the college. If any student fails to attend the verification process on the scheduled date and time, it will be assumed that he/she will not continue study in this college and he/she will also not be able to complete the University Registration Form Fill Up procedure from this college. Therefore, the admission of the student concerned in the college will stand cancelled.

Self-attested photocopies of the following testimonials are to be submitted during verification. Failing to submit any of the documents, verification of the concerned students cannot be done and admission will stand cancelled.

7. Hostel Admission
